### EXPECTATIONS OF STAFF IN A CHILD SAFE SCHOOL

Genazzano FCJ College is committed to creating and maintaining a child safe environment in which all students, including Aboriginal children and students with a disability, feel safe and are safe. ### POSITION OBJECTIVE

- To responsibly perform tasks associated with the efficient operation of the Science Laboratory. This includes assisting staff and students with technical advice and trialing of experiments.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Implementing and maintaining an orderly storage system in the laboratory and preparation rooms and ensuring all items are appropriately labeled, handled and disposed of according to safety protocols.
- Maintaining equipment in good working order and carrying out minor repairs where necessary.
- Liaising with teaching staff regarding experiments and requirements and the efficient allocation of materials and equipment.
- Assisting with displays in the Science area and caring for flora and fauna.
- Preparing and assisting teaching aids, under direction.

- Maintaining cleanliness of equipment and glassware, returning all used equipment to their appropriate storage area and returning completed practical requests to a central file.
- Preparing standard solutions and less complex experiments.
- Evaluating and making recommendations for the purchase of technical or computer equipment.
- Culturing, preparing for use and being responsible for the security of living materials, such as bacteria and tissue cultures.
- Maintaining booking and repair/replace systems for equipment.
- Attending and contributing to Science Curriculum Area meetings.
- Assisting with the design/demonstration of experiments and scientific equipment, as directed.
- Routine ordering and collection of supplies and materials.

#### **ACCOUNTABILITY & EXTENT OF AUTHORITY**

- The Laboratory Technician is accountable to the Curriculum Leader: Science
- For implementation of Child Safe Standards, this position is accountable to the Deputy Principal – Child Safe Officer
- The position must ensure that it operates in accordance with the specific objectives, policies and strategies determined for the effective management of the College's resources and ensure decisions made by the position are subject to review by the Curriculum Leader: Science.
